Africa is the world's second largest continent. It's so big that the USA could fit into it three times.

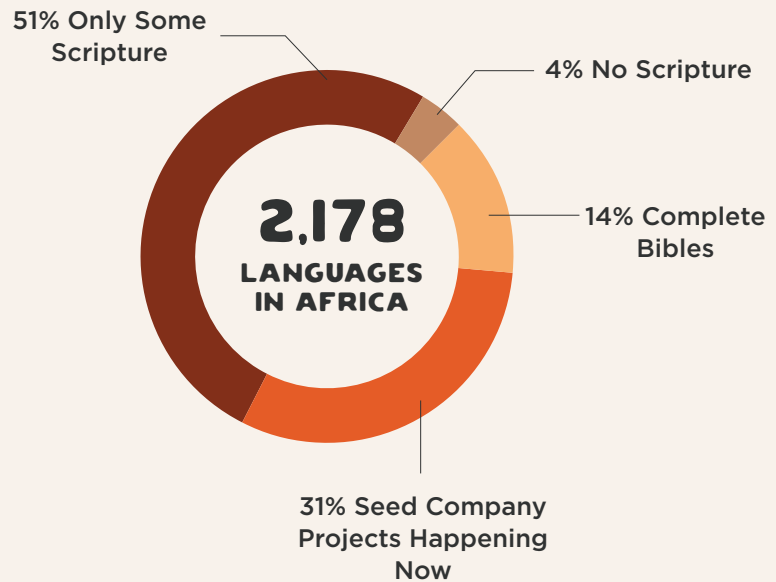
Lots of people visit Africa to go on Safari, where they can see animals like elephants, rhinos, and giraffes.
