## FUN FACTS ABOUT THE PACIFIC:



The Pacific Ocean is so big it covers more of the world than all of the earth's land.

The largest lizard, called a Komodo Dragon, can be found in Indonesia.

Over 800 languages are spoken by people in the country of Papua New Guinea.

The Pacific region is made up of many islands. Indonesia has over 17,000! The Philippines has 7,641 islands and Fiji has 333.

A Rafflesia Arnoldii, the world's largest flower is also in the Pacific, growing in the rainforests of Malaysia. It can measure up to 3 feet across! Maybe it's as big as you.

Sasi, a practice that puts specific areas of the ocean or forest in "quiet time," allows people in the Pacific region to fish and pick fruits in certain places and seasons while also allowing nature to rest and produce more.



## BIBLE TRANSLATION IN THE PACIFIC

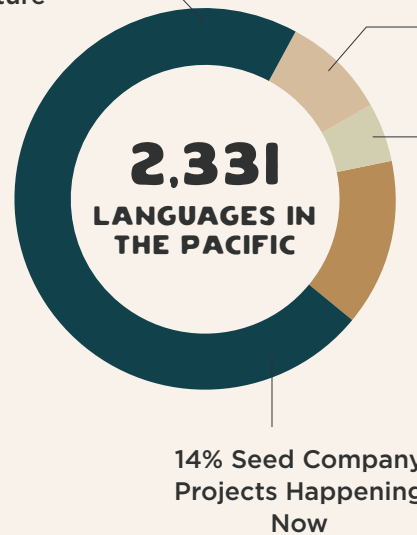
**TRANSLATION:** Changing words from one language into another so that people can understand.
