

MAKE A PACIFIC RAINBOW FISH

People in the Pacific often live on islands close to water. They travel by boat and go fishing for food. God provides for them, just like He gives you what you need. Make this fish craft as a reminder that He loves those on faraway islands and also loves you.



SUPPLIES YOU'LL NEED:

- Colored tissue paper or any paper that is easy to fold
- Googly eyes
- String, glue, scissors
- Toilet paper tube

STEPS TO TAKE:

1. Stand the toilet paper tube upright on the colored papers to trace circles.
2. Cut out 20+ circles of paper in various colors.
3. Cut 3" x 0.25" long strips of the same colored papers.
4. Start by gluing a row of overlapping circles and hang partially off the bottom of the tube.
5. Add rows of overlapping circles to go up from the bottom to the top of the tube. The last row can fold over the top of the tube (the head of the fish) and be glued to the inside.
6. Glue the rectangular strips of colored paper to the inside of the tube around the bottom.
7. Add googly eyes to the top of the tube on both sides of the face.
8. Cut a piece of string 6" or longer, make it into a loop and glue it to the inside of the top of the tube.

Hang your fish somewhere to remind you that God cares for people all over the world, including kids on the islands in the Pacific.
