

MAKE A BEAN MOSAIC

If you travel to the Middle East or Europe, in many places you can see beautiful, detailed mosaics made of different colored stones or glass. These pictures or patterns decorate walls or floors, furniture and fountains, sometimes even ceilings. You can use beans to make your own.



SUPPLIES YOU'LL NEED:

- Dried beans in a variety of colors and shapes
- Cardboard
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Shapes to trace (coasters, cups, bottle caps, etc.)

STEPS TO TAKE:

1. Cut out a piece of cardboard in any shape. Cardboard works better than paper as it is sturdy to support the heavy beans you will be adding to it.
2. Using a pencil and shapes to trace, draw out a design you'd like to follow.
3. Add glue directly to the cardboard in the section you are working on.
4. Glue beans down in a line or pattern. Tip: start in the center and work outward to help cover gaps in different size beans. Think about using contrasting color beans for fun visual appeal.
5. Let the project dry.

Hang your mosaic up and remember to pray for those who don't yet know the good news of the Bible in Europe and the Middle East.
